July 16: Edinburgh, Scotland: Arrival

July 17: Edinburgh, Scotland: To discover Edinburgh, head to its historic heart with

At the far end is the Palace of Holyroodhouse, the Queen's official residence when in Scotland. Buildings steeped in history line the route between the two, with most converted into shops, restaurants, and pubs.

golf-lovers paradise, this is the birthplace of the game and the perfect spot to squeeze in a round.
